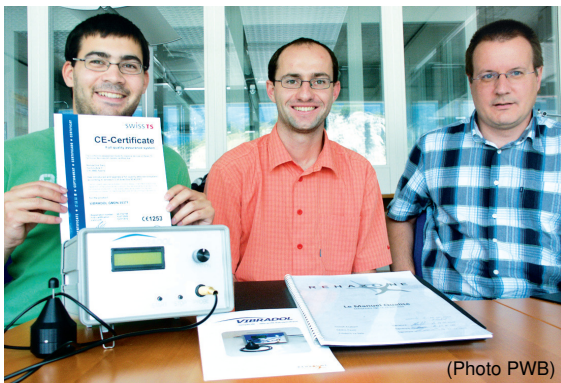


VIBRADOL Certified EC !

When is The Vibradol used?

The Vibradol is used in the treatment of neuropathic pain, such as neuralgias and neuromas.

What is neuropathic pain?

Neuropathic pain is a condition caused by an lesion (injury caused by a fall, a cut, a psychological trauma, etc.) or a dysfunction of the nerves that perceive pain. This pain is often described as throbbing or stabbing, burning or prickling, or like receiving an electric shock.
